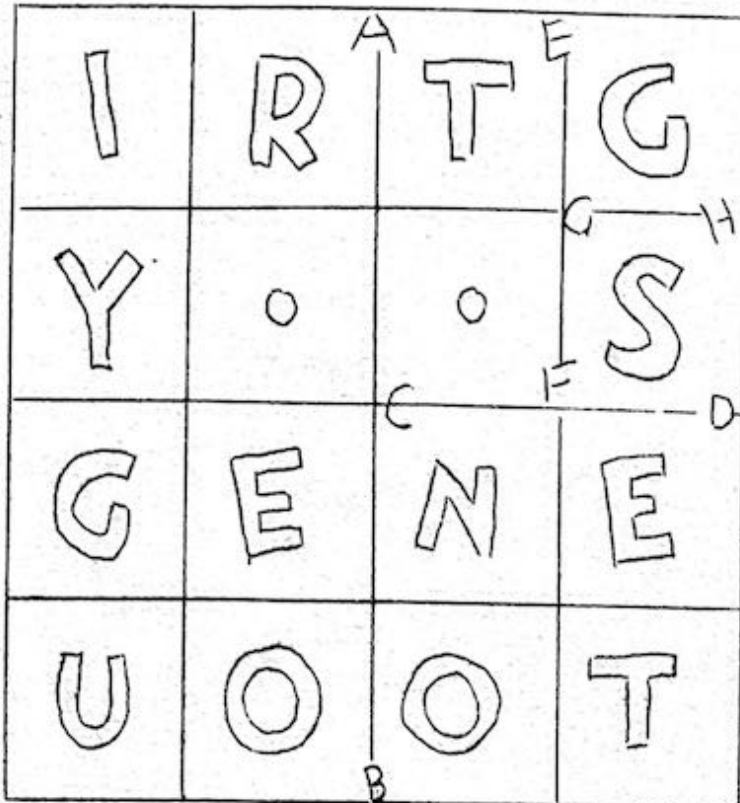

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C R A Z Y C U T - U P S

An amusing Party Stunt.

Have a square of paper marked in 16 squares with letters and periods as in sketch.

To decipher the puzzle, tear from A to B; and place the right hand portion on top of the left. Then tear across from C to D, and place the upper portion on top of the lower. Tear again from E to F, and place the right hand portion on top of left. Then tear from G to H, and place upper portion on lower - and you have a pack of small pieces - one letter on each.

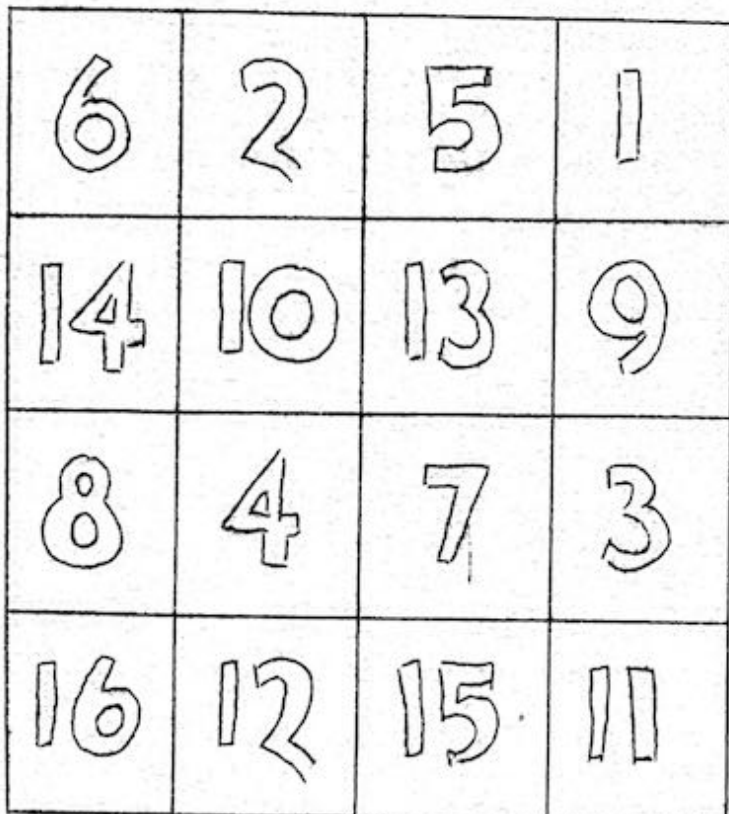
Deal the pieces, one at a time, in a row from left to right, and you will form an intelligible message.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR OWN

The diagram at the left shows the sequence of the letters. Decide upon any words or message appropriate to the occasion, and use 16 letters to express it. Blanks may be used - or periods - or omitted, as desired. Place the first letter on square 1; next letter on square 2, etc.

Some suggested wordings:

- A.HAPPY.BIRTHDAY
- MERRIE CHRISTMAS
- A.HAPPY.NEW.YEAR
- CAN.YOU.BEAT.IT?
- BE. MY.VALENTINE
- KILROY.WAS.HERE! - I.AM.A.
